UNGC is the world's largest sustainability initiative aiming to build a sound global society through partnership between the United Nations and the private sector (companies and groups). The signatories to UNGC are required to submit a CEO statement of continued support for the Ten Principles in the areas of human rights protection, elimination of unfair labor practices, environmental responsibility, and prevention of corruption and to make continuous efforts to realize those principles.

JTB Group's Mission is "to foster peace and global interconnectedness through the creation of opportunities for meaningful human interaction," which precisely means to contribute to building a sustainable society. We are currently promoting sustainability initiatives on a global level based on our Sustainability Policy formulated in 2022.
